

Design with carpet: A Rug



Rug drives narrative and expresses the character of an environment through its materiality and sensoriality.

Over the years it has become more and more unconventional and today, it is considered a design element with great expressive power.



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This manual will guide you through the different options when designing a rug for residential and public spaces.

Five simple steps help you choose and implement the best solution for your project.

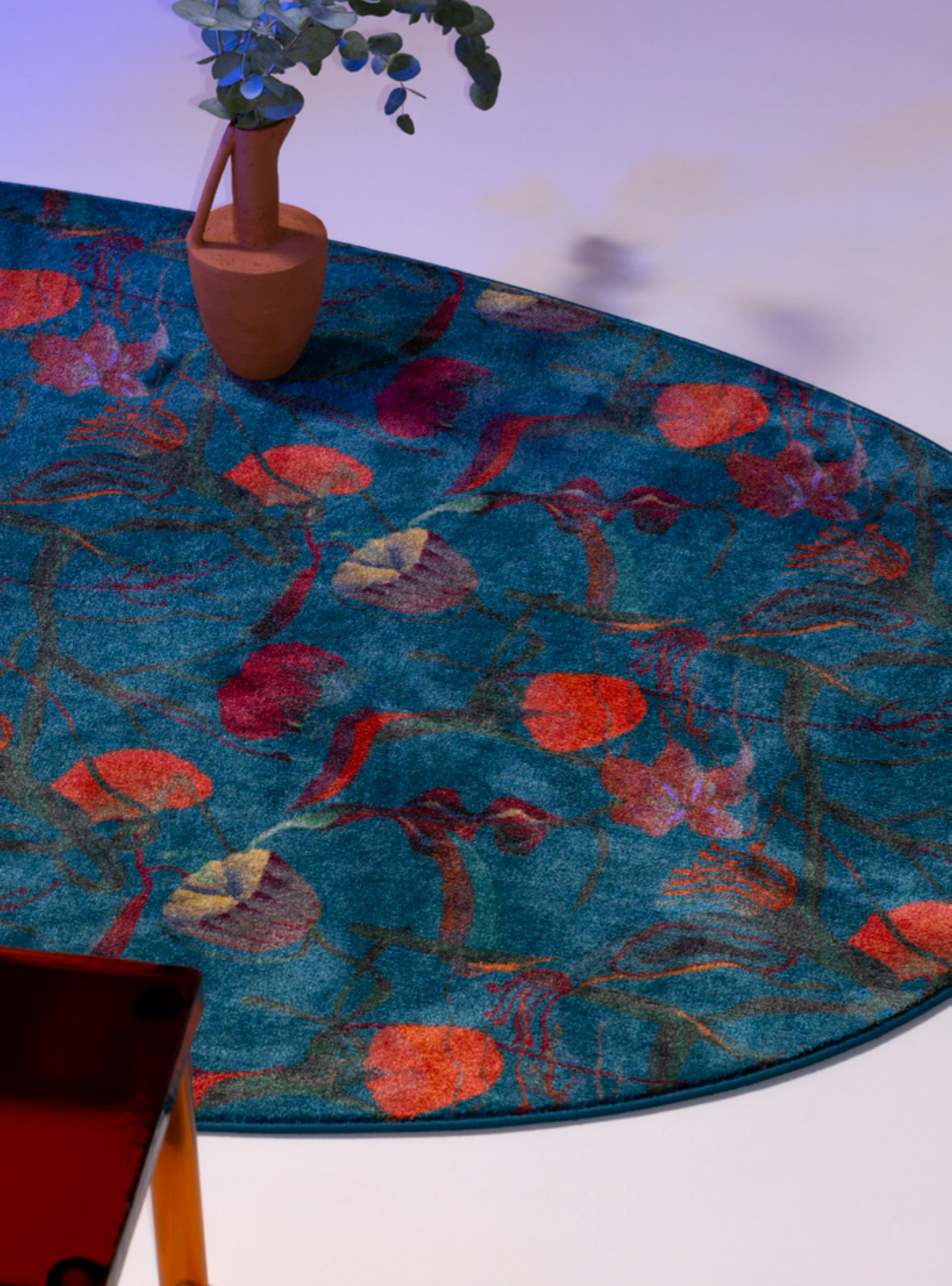

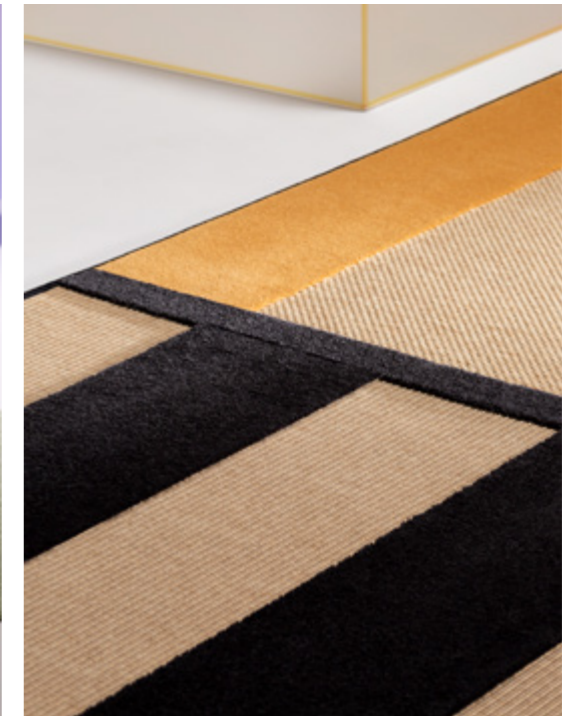

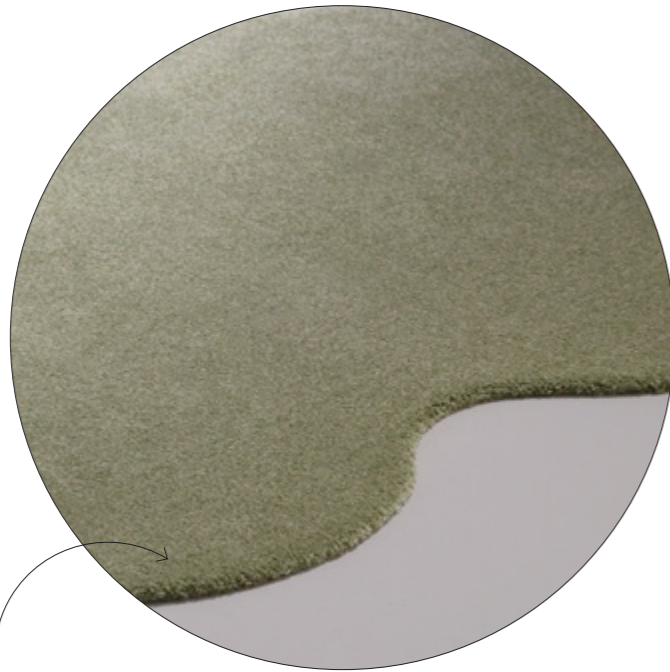

One look

To create a One Look rug, pick a product from our collection choosing either **Plain**, **Texture** or **Decorative**. Each category has different technical and aesthetic characteristics.



One look Plain

Look for the symbol ◆

The Plain category includes all monocolored carpets ranging in brightness, thickness and color. These styles allow you to create tonal looks or lively color contrasts between the floor and the rug.

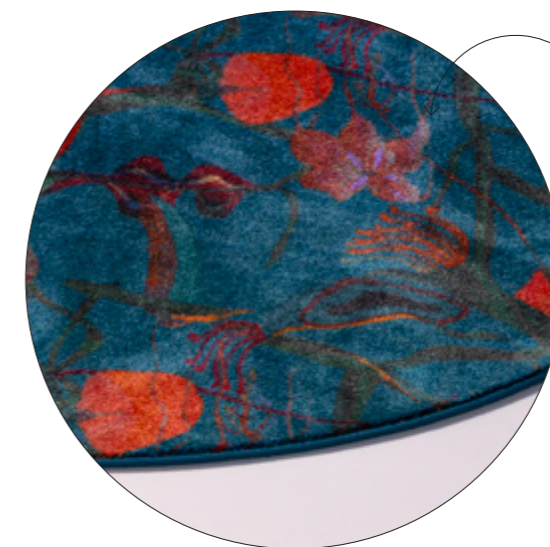
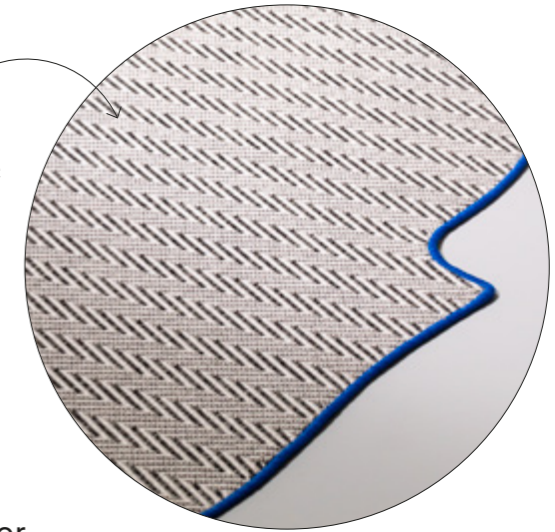

The Texture category includes products with unique structural textures and three-dimensional motifs. The material effect of rugs made using these styles can be contrasted with the floor to create a room with strong character.

The Decorative category is defined by geometric patterns, lively graphics and sophisticated designs. Within this category you will find proposals created by established designers.

A **Plain** rug with an organic shape and high-thickness creates an important sensorial effect.

The sinuous shape is accentuated by the thickness of the pile, creating a soft and voluminous effect.

The irregular shape and texture of the product creates a striking contrast.

Mix&Match

The Mix&Match rug is created by combining two or more products using carpet inlays.

This technique allows you to create designs and geometries with different decorative and three-dimensional effects. Select your products from the three different categories – **Plain**, **Texture** and **Decorative** categories (see pages 6–7) – and mix them to create the desired effect.

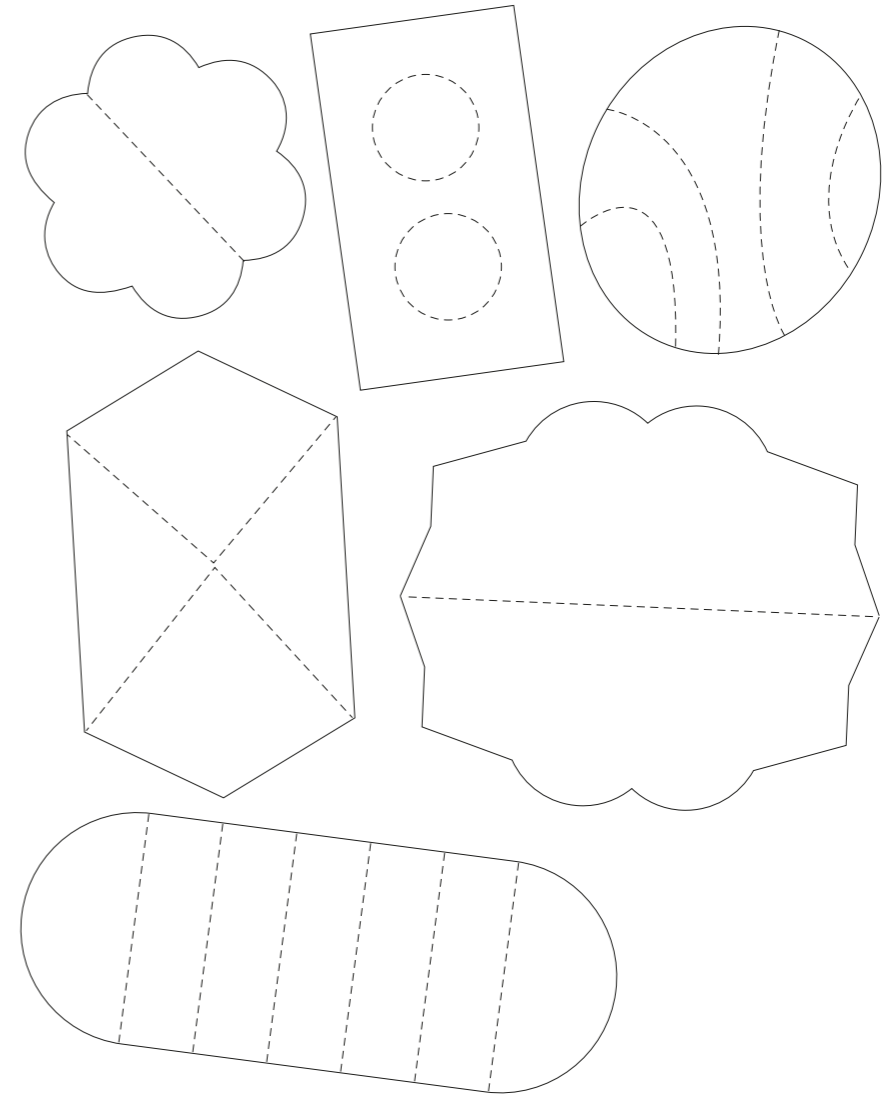

Step 1

Define the shape and size.
It is possible to create classic geometries, free shapes or complex compositions.



Once the shape is defined, it's time to create the design. Divide the surface into sections and combine your preferred product categories.

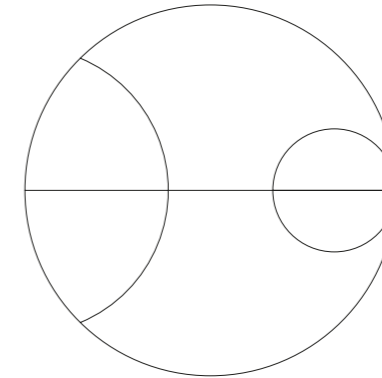


A tone-on-tone border featuring two different colors. The edge of this rug blends in with the design thanks to a border made with the same shades selected for the rug.

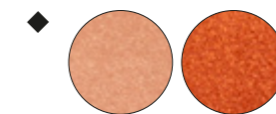

The design of this rug is made using 2 Plain products in different shades that enhance the intersection of the circular shapes.

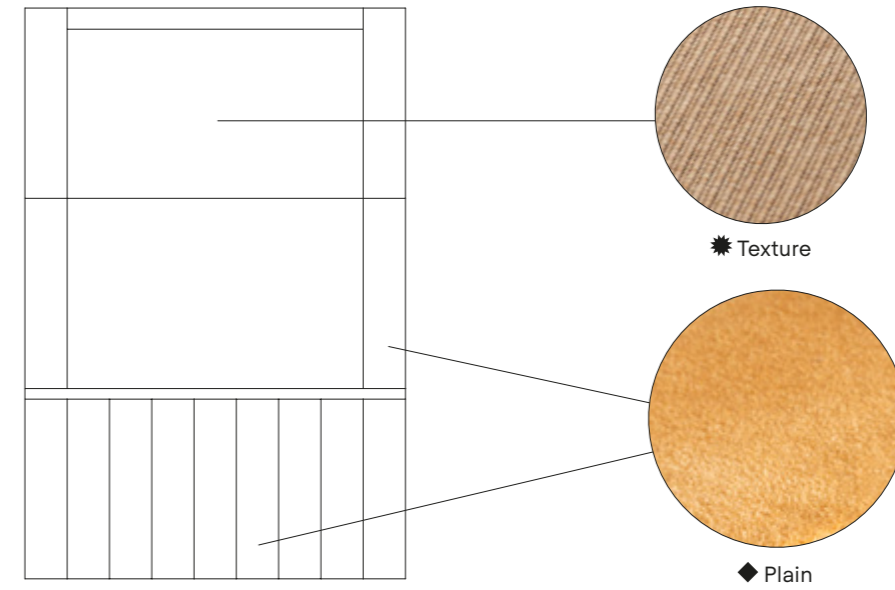


The geometric composition is made with single products joined together with a custom inlay.

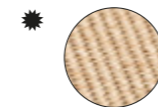


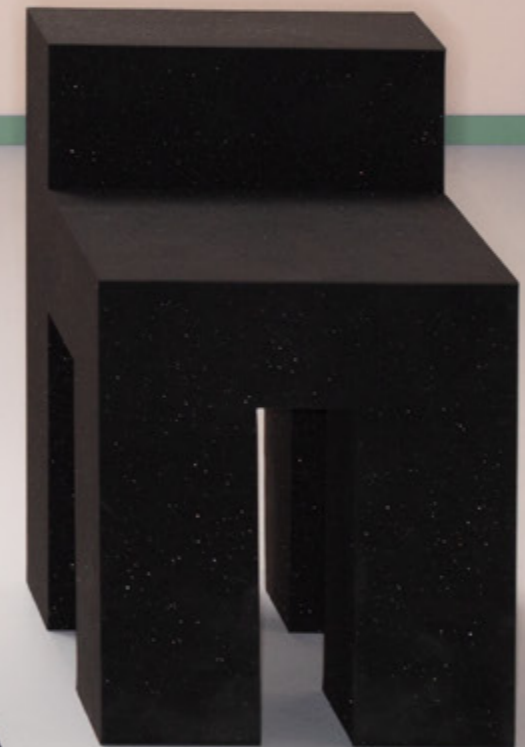
This design is created by joining together 2 Plain products in different color shades and 1 Texture product with a natural tone and textural effect.

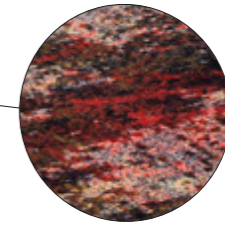
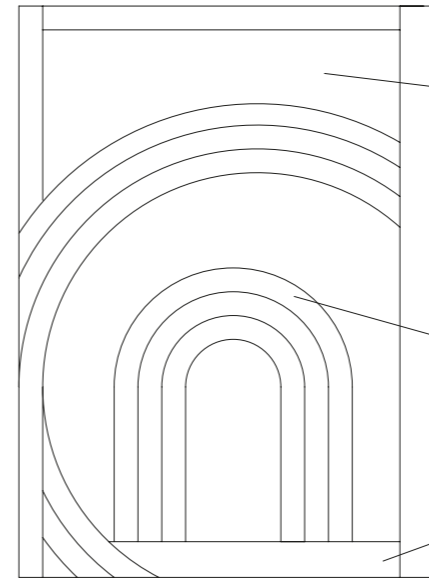
An optical interplay of curves and intersecting lines with an abstract background.



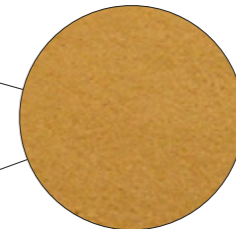

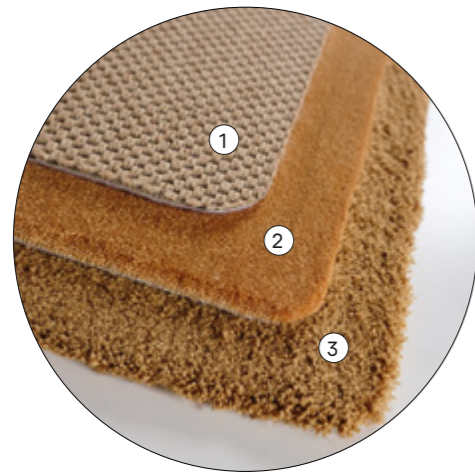
Now that you have chosen between **One Look** and **Mix&Match** you can move on to the next step

Step 2

What effect do you want to achieve?

The thickness of the product defines the aesthetic, visual and sensorial effect of the rug. The floor textiles are divided into three thicknesses with different technical and aesthetic characteristics.

One Look rugs are made up of a single product. The thickness of the carpet defines the visual and sensorial effect.



- ① **Low thickness**
The pile is very short or shaved, compact and resistant.
- ② **Medium thickness**
The pile is straight and resistant with various heights depending on the volume you desire.
- ③ **High thickness**
The pile is high and soft, guaranteeing a rich and fluffy effect.

If a Mix&Match rug is made with products of different thicknesses, you will see a slight difference in height between products. This difference creates a high or bas-relief effect depending on the combined heights. If products of the same or similar thickness are used the difference will not be perceived and the inlay will appear flat.

Step 2

An inlay with a high-relief effect obtained by combining a Texture product and a Plain product with a higher thickness.

An inlay with a bas-relief effect obtained by combining a high-thickness product from the Plain category and a low thickness product of the Texture category.

Step 4 Borders

You can choose from seven different types of borders, including both bold and more subtle options. For all borders, excluding the lapelled border and the slim ribbon border, it is possible to select any color to either match or contrast the rug.

The yarn border allows you to have the same matching color when you combine different carpets.
